Sadie Harrison is a UK- based composer known particularly for the socio-political aspects of her music-making with works challenging stereotypes of marginalised peoples, celebrating their creativity and individuality. For several years, Sadie pursued a secondary career as an archaeologist. Reflecting this interest in the past, many of her compositions have been inspired by the traditional musics of old and extant cultures with cycles of pieces based on the folk music of Afghanistan, Lithuania, the Isle of Skye, the Northern Caucasus and the UK. She has been Composer-in-Residence with Cuatro Puntos Kunstler Bei Wu Sculpturepark (Germany), and Composer-in-Association with the Afghanistan National Institute of Music. Her symphonic work Sapida-Dam-Nau for Afghanistan Women's Orchestra was premiered at the Closing Concert of the World Economic Forum, Davos in 2017. Recent projects supported by Arts Council England, Ambache Charitable Trust, PRSF, Hinrichsen Foundation and RVW Trust have included Pasture & Storm with virtuoso left hand pianist Nicholas McCarthy seeing the creation of 8 new works for disabled pianists, the recording released on Prima Facie in 2022; written for Alex Wilson, the 30 minute cycle Dear Cleg was premiered in Southwark Cathedral and released on Prima Facie in 2023; celebrating the work of artists still women Afghanistan, Uncaged a new ballet score for string quintet (Cuatro Puntos) and Ekklesia Contemporary Ballet Company commissioned for performances in Connecticut, USA, March 2025. Recordings for 2024/2025 include 10,000 Black Men (Kreutzer String Quartet) Nani ka itou?
